Changing the background of a video using Chroma Keying


In this section we shall change the background of the video into a picture.

Step 1:


Import the video (.avi) file and the wallpaper (.jpg) into the project bin as seen earlier.

Step 2:

Move the video onto the first track. Note that we have selected the video with a green background to enable the chroma key filter.




Step 3: Move the image onto the track below the video because it is to be the lower layer.




Step 4:

Extend the timeline of the still picture to the full length of the video by clicking on its far- right end and dragging it to the position you desire.



Step 5:

Next, click on the track with the video and select the Editor \rightarrow Effect \rightarrow Keyers \rightarrow StudioChromaKeyer




The background shall be changed successfully



Settings Review



You may enable/disable the visibility of a track by clicking on the eye button next to the track.



You may enable/disable the audio of a track by clicking on the speaker button next to the track.



You may lock/unlock the track by clicking on the lock button next to the track to enable/disable any editing of the track respectively.
